Primary Schools

During this time I continued to monitor the program in schools, providing training on Financial Education to 10 teachers and donating 15 copies of the book "PRINCIPLES THAT MAKE YOU STRONG," based on Psalm 1, to the schools.

The donation of the books was not continued due to lack of inventory, it is something that has a great future because the teachers love the proposal that their children read the story using their own book.

Talks to parents

I gave 5 talks to parents with topics such as: Helping their children in their studies, Raising children with principles and values, and communication in the family. About 400 parents attended.

So far this year 800 parents have attended these talks.

High Schools

In the high schools, the activities were very productive. I gave 12 talks to about 800 young people with topics on Financial Education, Entrepreneurship, Positive attitude towards studies and the importance of academic excellence.

During the year, 1,100 young people attended these talks.

National University in Honduras (CURC)

At CURC I gave 6 talks to students of Agroindustrial Engineering, Business Administration and International Trade. About 120 young people attended.

During the year 173 young people heard these talks.

The National Center for the Development of Values (CNFV), is a building built by Professionals to the World. I am working with the university to implement a program to use this building for which it was intended. The program is called SEALO and provides training in the teaching of values in the classroom for the entire university system concluding with a diploma for those who successfully pass the course. I have taken this course myself and have a diploma. For the next period I hope to develop talks give in this building to give it more emphasis.

I am also helping with an entrepreneurship course at the university. Our country has a high unemployment rate and this training is intended to help young people start their own business.

Multiplying Two for Jesus (M2J)

Through the accounting tutorials, 3 students completed the 2-week Discipleship program.
