

Eph. 1:1 Paul, <sup>a</sup>an apostle of <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus <sup>1c</sup>by the will of God, to the <sup>2d</sup>saints who are <sup>3</sup>at <sup>e</sup>Ephesus, and <sup>f</sup>who are faithful in <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus: 2 <sup>a</sup>Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Eph. 1:3 <sup>a</sup>Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in <sup>b</sup>the heavenly *places* in Christ, 4 just as <sup>a</sup>He chose us in Him before <sup>b</sup>the foundation of the world, that we should be <sup>c</sup>holy and blameless before <sup>1</sup>Him. <sup>d</sup>In love 5 <sup>1</sup>He <sup>a</sup>predestined us to <sup>b</sup>adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, <sup>c</sup>according to the <sup>2</sup>kind intention of His will, 6 <sup>a</sup>to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in <sup>b</sup>the Beloved. 7 <sup>a</sup>In <sup>1</sup>Him we have <sup>b</sup>redemption <sup>c</sup>through His blood, the <sup>d</sup>forgiveness of our trespasses, according to <sup>e</sup>the riches of His grace, 8 which He <sup>1</sup>lavished upon <sup>2</sup>us. In all wisdom and insight 9 He <sup>1a</sup>made known to us the mystery of His will, <sup>b</sup>according to His <sup>2</sup>kind intention which He <sup>c</sup>purposed in Him 10 with a view to an administration <sup>1</sup>suitable to <sup>a</sup>the fulness of the times, *that is*, <sup>b</sup>the summing up of all things in Christ, things <sup>2</sup>in the heavens and things upon the earth. In Him 11 <sup>1</sup>also we <sup>2a</sup>have obtained an inheritance, having been <sup>b</sup>predestined <sup>c</sup>according to His purpose who works all things <sup>d</sup>after the counsel of His will, 12 to the end that we who were the first to hope in <sup>1</sup>Christ should be <sup>a</sup>to the praise of His glory. 13 In <sup>1</sup>Him, you also, after listening to <sup>a</sup>the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation — having also <sup>2</sup>believed, you were <sup>b</sup>sealed in <sup>1</sup>Him with <sup>c</sup>the Holy Spirit of promise, 14 who is <sup>1a</sup>given as a pledge of <sup>b</sup>our inheritance, with a view to the <sup>c</sup>redemption of <sup>d</sup>God's own possession, <sup>e</sup>to the praise of His glory.

Eph. 1:15 For this reason I too, <sup>a</sup>having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which *exists* among you, and <sup>1</sup>your love for <sup>b</sup>all the <sup>2</sup>saints, 16 <sup>a</sup>do not cease giving thanks for you, <sup>b</sup>while making mention *of you* in my prayers; 17 that the <sup>a</sup>God of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>b</sup>the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of <sup>c</sup>wisdom and of <sup>d</sup>revelation in the <sup>1</sup>knowledge of Him. 18 *I pray that* <sup>a</sup>the eyes of your heart <sup>1</sup>may be enlightened, so that you may know what is the <sup>b</sup>hope of His <sup>c</sup>calling, what are <sup>d</sup>the riches of the glory of <sup>e</sup>His inheritance in <sup>f</sup>the <sup>2</sup>saints, 19 and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. <sup>a</sup>*These are* in accordance with the working of the <sup>b</sup>strength of His might 20 which He brought about in Christ, when He <sup>a</sup>raised Him from the dead, and <sup>b</sup>seated Him at His right hand in <sup>c</sup>the heavenly *places*, 21 far above <sup>a</sup>all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every <sup>b</sup>name that is named, not only in <sup>c</sup>this age, but also in the one to come. 22 And He <sup>a</sup>put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as <sup>b</sup>head over all things to the church, 23 which is His <sup>a</sup>body, the <sup>b</sup>fulness of Him who <sup>c</sup>fills <sup>d</sup>all in all.

Eph. 2:1 And you <sup>1</sup>were <sup>a</sup>dead <sup>2</sup>in your trespasses and sins, 2 in which you <sup>a</sup>formerly walked according to the <sup>1</sup>course of <sup>b</sup>this world, according to <sup>c</sup>the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in <sup>d</sup>the sons of disobedience. 3 Among them we too all <sup>a</sup>formerly lived in <sup>b</sup>the lusts of our flesh, <sup>1</sup>indulging the desires of the flesh and of the <sup>2</sup>mind, and were <sup>c</sup>by nature <sup>d</sup>children of wrath, <sup>e</sup>even as the rest. 4 But God, being <sup>a</sup>rich in mercy, because of <sup>b</sup>His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were <sup>a</sup>dead <sup>1</sup>in our transgressions, made us alive together <sup>2</sup>with Christ (<sup>b</sup>by grace you have been saved), 6 and <sup>a</sup>raised us up with Him, and <sup>b</sup>seated us with Him in <sup>c</sup>the heavenly *places*, in <sup>d</sup>Christ Jesus, 7 in order that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing <sup>a</sup>riches of His grace in <sup>b</sup>kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. 8 For <sup>a</sup>by grace you have been saved <sup>b</sup>through faith; and <sup>1</sup>that not of yourselves, *it is* <sup>c</sup>the gift of God; 9 <sup>a</sup>not as a result of works, that <sup>b</sup>no one should boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, <sup>a</sup>created in <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus for <sup>c</sup>good works, which God <sup>d</sup>prepared beforehand, that we should <sup>e</sup>walk in them.

Eph. 2:11 Therefore remember, that <sup>a</sup>formerly <sup>b</sup>you, the Gentiles in the flesh, who are called "<sup>c</sup>Uncircumcision" by the so-called "<sup>c</sup>Circumcision," *which is* performed in the

flesh by human hands — 12 *remember* that you were at that time separate from Christ, <sup>1</sup>excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to <sup>b</sup>the covenants of promise, having <sup>c</sup>no hope and <sup>d</sup>without God in the world. 13 But now in <sup>a</sup>Christ Jesus you who <sup>b</sup>formerly were <sup>c</sup>far off <sup>1</sup>have <sup>c</sup>been brought near <sup>2</sup>by the blood of Christ. 14 For He Himself is <sup>a</sup>our peace, <sup>b</sup>who made both *groups into* one, and broke down the <sup>1</sup>barrier of the dividing wall, 15 <sup>1</sup>by <sup>a</sup>abolishing in His flesh the enmity, *which is* <sup>b</sup>the Law of commandments *contained* in ordinances, that in Himself He might <sup>2</sup>make the two into <sup>d</sup>one new man, *thus* establishing <sup>e</sup>peace, 16 and might <sup>a</sup>reconcile them both in <sup>b</sup>one body to God through the cross, <sup>1</sup>by it having <sup>c</sup>put to death the enmity. 17 And <sup>a</sup>He Came And Preached <sup>b</sup>Peace To You Who Were <sup>c</sup>Far Away, And Peace To Those Who Were <sup>c</sup>Near; 18 for through Him we both have <sup>a</sup>our access in <sup>b</sup>one Spirit to <sup>c</sup>the Father. 19 So then you are no longer <sup>a</sup>strangers and aliens, but you are <sup>b</sup>fellow citizens with the <sup>1</sup>saints, and are of <sup>c</sup>God's household, 20 having been <sup>a</sup>built upon <sup>b</sup>the foundation of <sup>c</sup>the apostles and prophets, <sup>d</sup>Christ Jesus Himself being the <sup>e</sup>corner stone, 21 <sup>a</sup>in whom the whole building, being fitted together is growing into <sup>b</sup>a holy <sup>1</sup>temple in the Lord; 22 in whom you also are being <sup>a</sup>built together into a <sup>b</sup>dwelling of God in the Spirit.

Eph. 3:1 For this reason I, Paul, <sup>a</sup>the prisoner of <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus <sup>c</sup>for the sake of you <sup>d</sup>Gentiles — 2 if indeed you have heard of the <sup>a</sup>stewardship of God's grace which was given to me for you; 3 <sup>a</sup>that <sup>b</sup>by revelation there was <sup>c</sup>made known to me <sup>d</sup>the mystery, <sup>e</sup>as I wrote before in brief. 4 <sup>1</sup>And by referring to this, when you read you can understand <sup>a</sup>my insight <sup>2</sup>into the <sup>b</sup>mystery of Christ, 5 which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed to His holy <sup>a</sup>apostles and prophets <sup>1</sup>in the Spirit; 6 *to be specific*, that the Gentiles are <sup>a</sup>fellow heirs and <sup>b</sup>fellow members of the body, and <sup>c</sup>fellow partakers of the promise in <sup>d</sup>Christ Jesus through the gospel, 7 <sup>a</sup>of which I was made a <sup>b</sup>minister, according to the gift of <sup>c</sup>God's grace which was given to me <sup>d</sup>according to the working of His power. 8 To me, <sup>a</sup>the very least of all <sup>1</sup>saints, this grace was given, to <sup>b</sup>preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable <sup>c</sup>riches of Christ, 9 and to <sup>1</sup>bring to light what is the administration of the <sup>a</sup>mystery which for ages has been <sup>b</sup>hidden in God, <sup>c</sup>who created all things; 10 in order that the manifold <sup>a</sup>wisdom of God might now be <sup>b</sup>made known through the church to the <sup>c</sup>rulers and the authorities in <sup>d</sup>the heavenly *places*. 11 *This was* in <sup>a</sup>accordance with the <sup>1</sup>eternal purpose which He <sup>2</sup>carried out in <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus our Lord, 12 in whom we have boldness and <sup>1</sup>aconfident <sup>b</sup>access through faith <sup>2</sup>in Him. 13 Therefore I ask <sup>1</sup>you not <sup>a</sup>to lose heart at my tribulations <sup>b</sup>on your behalf, <sup>2</sup>for they are your glory.

Eph. 3:14 For this reason, I <sup>a</sup>bow my knees before the Father, 15 from whom <sup>1</sup>every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, 16 that He would grant you, according to <sup>a</sup>the riches of His glory, to be <sup>b</sup>strengthened with power through His Spirit in <sup>c</sup>the inner man; 17 so that <sup>a</sup>Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; *and* that you, being <sup>b</sup>rooted and <sup>c</sup>grounded in love, 18 may be able to comprehend with <sup>a</sup>all the <sup>1</sup>saints what is <sup>b</sup>the breadth and length and height and depth, 19 and to know <sup>a</sup>the love of Christ which <sup>b</sup>surpasses knowledge, that you may be <sup>c</sup>filled up to all the <sup>d</sup>fulness of God.

Eph. 3:20 <sup>a</sup>Now to Him who is <sup>b</sup>able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, <sup>c</sup>according to the power that works within us, 21 <sup>a</sup>to Him *be* the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations <sup>1</sup>forever and ever. Amen.

Eph. 4:1 I, therefore, <sup>a</sup>the prisoner of the Lord, <sup>b</sup>entreat you to <sup>c</sup>walk in a manner worthy of the <sup>d</sup>calling with which you have been <sup>e</sup>called, 2 with all <sup>a</sup>humility and gentleness, with patience, showing forbearance to one another <sup>b</sup>in love, 3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the <sup>a</sup>bond of peace. 4 *There is* <sup>a</sup>one body

and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one <sup>b</sup>hope of your calling; 5 <sup>a</sup>one Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6 one God and Father of all <sup>a</sup>who is over all and through all and in all. 7 But <sup>a</sup>to each one of us <sup>b</sup>grace was given <sup>c</sup>according to the measure of Christ's gift. 8 Therefore <sup>1</sup>it says,

<sup>a</sup>When He Ascended On High,  
He <sup>b</sup>Led Captive A Host Of Captives,  
And He Gave Gifts To Men."

9 (Now this *expression*, "He <sup>a</sup>ascended," what <sup>1</sup>does it mean except that He also <sup>2</sup>had descended into <sup>b</sup>the lower parts of the earth? 10 He who descended is Himself also He who ascended <sup>a</sup>far above all the heavens, that He might <sup>b</sup>fill all things.) 11 And He <sup>a</sup>gave <sup>b</sup>some *as* apostles, and some *as* prophets, and some *as* evangelists, and some *as* pastors and <sup>d</sup>teachers, 12 <sup>a</sup>for the equipping of the <sup>1</sup>saints for the work of service, to the building up of <sup>b</sup>the body of Christ; 13 until we all attain to <sup>a</sup>the unity of the faith, and of the <sup>1b</sup>knowledge of the Son of God, to a <sup>c</sup>mature man, to the measure of the stature <sup>2</sup>which belongs to the <sup>d</sup>fulness of Christ. 14 <sup>1</sup>As a result, we are <sup>a</sup>no longer to be children, <sup>b</sup>tossed here and there by waves, and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by <sup>c</sup>craftiness <sup>2</sup>in <sup>d</sup>deceitful scheming; 15 but <sup>1</sup>speaking the truth <sup>a</sup>in love, we <sup>2</sup>are to <sup>b</sup>grow up in all *aspects* into Him, who is the <sup>c</sup>head, *even* Christ, 16 from whom <sup>a</sup>the whole body, being fitted and held together <sup>1</sup>by that which every joint supplies, according to the <sup>2</sup>proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself <sup>b</sup>in love.

Eph. 4:17 <sup>a</sup>This I say therefore, and affirm together with the Lord, <sup>b</sup>that you walk no longer just as the Gentiles also walk, in the <sup>c</sup>futility of their mind, 18 being <sup>a</sup>darkened in their understanding, <sup>1b</sup>excluded from the life of God, because of the <sup>c</sup>ignorance that is in them, because of the <sup>d</sup>hardness of their heart; 19 and they, having <sup>a</sup>become callous, <sup>b</sup>have given themselves over to <sup>c</sup>sensuality, <sup>1</sup>for the practice of every kind of impurity with greediness. 20 But you did not <sup>a</sup>learn <sup>1</sup>Christ in this way, 21 if indeed you <sup>a</sup>have heard Him and have <sup>b</sup>been taught in Him, just as truth is in Jesus, 22 that, in reference to your former manner of life, you <sup>a</sup>lay aside the <sup>b</sup>old <sup>1</sup>self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the <sup>c</sup>lusts of deceit, 23 and that you be <sup>a</sup>renewed in the spirit of your mind, 24 and <sup>a</sup>put on the <sup>b</sup>new <sup>1</sup>self, which <sup>2c</sup>in *the likeness of God* has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

Eph. 4:25 Therefore, <sup>a</sup>laying aside falsehood, <sup>b</sup>Speak Truth, Each One *of you*, With His Neighbor, for we are <sup>c</sup>members of one another. 26 <sup>a</sup>Be Angry, And *yet* Do Not Sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, 27 and do not <sup>a</sup>give the devil <sup>1</sup>an opportunity. 28 Let him who steals steal no longer; but rather <sup>a</sup>let him labor, <sup>b</sup>performing with his own hands what is good, <sup>c</sup>in order that he may have *something* to share with him who has need. 29 Let no <sup>1a</sup>unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such <sup>a</sup>word as is good for <sup>b</sup>edification <sup>2</sup>according to the need *of the moment*, that it may give grace to those who hear. 30 And <sup>a</sup>do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, <sup>1</sup>by whom you were <sup>b</sup>sealed for the day of redemption. 31 <sup>a</sup>Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be <sup>b</sup>put away from you, along with all <sup>c</sup>malice. 32 And <sup>a</sup>be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, <sup>b</sup>just as God in Christ also has forgiven <sup>1</sup>you.

Eph. 5:1 <sup>a</sup>Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; 2 and <sup>a</sup>walk in love, just as Christ also <sup>b</sup>loved <sup>1</sup>you, and <sup>c</sup>gave Himself up for us, an <sup>d</sup>offering and a sacrifice to God <sup>2</sup>as a <sup>e</sup>fragrant aroma.

Eph. 5:3 But do not let <sup>a</sup>immorality <sup>1</sup>or any impurity or greed even be named among you, as is proper among <sup>2</sup>saints; 4 and *there must be no* <sup>a</sup>filthiness and silly talk, or coarse jesting, which <sup>b</sup>are not fitting, but rather <sup>c</sup>giving of thanks. 5 For this you know with certainty, that <sup>a</sup>no <sup>1</sup>immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an

idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom <sup>b</sup>of Christ and God. 6 <sup>a</sup>Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things <sup>b</sup>the wrath of God comes upon <sup>c</sup>the sons of disobedience. 7 Therefore do not be <sup>a</sup>partakers with them; 8 for <sup>a</sup>you were formerly <sup>b</sup>darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as <sup>c</sup>children of light 9 (for <sup>a</sup>the fruit of the light *consists* in all <sup>b</sup>goodness and righteousness and truth), 10 <sup>1a</sup>trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. 11 And <sup>a</sup>do not participate in the unfruitful <sup>b</sup>deeds of <sup>c</sup>darkness, but instead even <sup>1d</sup>expose them; 12 for it is disgraceful even to speak of the things which are done by them in secret. 13 But all things become visible <sup>a</sup>when they are <sup>1</sup>exposed by the light, for everything that becomes visible is light. 14 For this reason <sup>1</sup>it says,  
“<sup>a</sup>Awake, sleeper,  
And arise from <sup>b</sup>the dead,  
And Christ <sup>c</sup>will shine on you.”

Eph. 5:15 Therefore <sup>1</sup>be careful how you <sup>a</sup>walk, not <sup>b</sup>as unwise men, but as wise, 16 <sup>1a</sup>making the most of your time, because <sup>b</sup>the days are evil. 17 So then do not be foolish, but <sup>a</sup>understand what the will of the Lord is. 18 And <sup>a</sup>do not get drunk with wine, <sup>1</sup>for that is <sup>b</sup>dissipation, but be <sup>c</sup>filled with the Spirit, 19 <sup>a</sup>speaking to <sup>1</sup>one another in <sup>b</sup>psalms and <sup>c</sup>hymns and spiritual <sup>d</sup>songs, <sup>e</sup>singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord; 20 <sup>a</sup>always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to <sup>1b</sup>God, even the Father; 21 <sup>1a</sup>and be subject to one another in the <sup>2b</sup>fear of Christ.

Eph. 5:22 <sup>a</sup>Wives, <sup>b</sup>be subject to your own husbands, <sup>c</sup>as to the Lord. 23 For <sup>a</sup>the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the <sup>b</sup>head of the church, He Himself <sup>c</sup>being the Savior of the body. 24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything. 25 <sup>a</sup>Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and <sup>b</sup>gave Himself up for her; 26 <sup>a</sup>that He might sanctify her, having <sup>b</sup>cleansed her by the <sup>c</sup>washing of water with <sup>d</sup>the word, 27 that He might <sup>a</sup>present to Himself the church <sup>1</sup>in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she should be <sup>b</sup>holy and blameless. 28 So husbands ought also to <sup>a</sup>love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; 29 for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also *does* the church, 30 because we are <sup>a</sup>members of His <sup>b</sup>body. 31 <sup>a</sup>For This Cause A Man Shall Leave His Father And Mother, And Shall Cleave To His Wife; And The Two Shall Become One Flesh. 32 This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. 33 Nevertheless let each individual among you also <sup>a</sup>love his own wife even as himself; and *let* the wife *see to it* that she <sup>1b</sup>respect her husband.

Eph. 6:1 <sup>a</sup>Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 2 <sup>a</sup>Honor Your Father And Mother (which is the first commandment with a promise), 3 That It May Be Well With You, And That You May Live Long On The Earth. 4 And, <sup>a</sup>fathers, do not provoke your children to anger; but <sup>b</sup>bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Eph. 6:5 <sup>a</sup>Slaves, be obedient to those who are your <sup>1</sup>masters according to the flesh, with <sup>b</sup>fear and trembling, in the sincerity of your heart, <sup>c</sup>as to Christ; 6 <sup>a</sup>not <sup>1</sup>by way of eyeservice, as <sup>b</sup>men-pleasers, but as <sup>c</sup>slaves of Christ, <sup>d</sup>doing the will of God from the <sup>2</sup>heart. 7 With good will <sup>1</sup>render service, <sup>a</sup>as to the Lord, and not to men, 8 <sup>a</sup>knowing that <sup>b</sup>whatever good thing each one does, this he will receive back from the Lord, <sup>c</sup>whether slave or free. 9 And, masters, do the same things to them, and <sup>a</sup>give up threatening, knowing that <sup>b</sup>both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is <sup>c</sup>no partiality with Him.

Eph. 6:10 Finally, <sup>a</sup>be strong in the Lord, and in <sup>b</sup>the strength of His might. 11 <sup>a</sup>Put

on the full armor of God, that you may be able to stand firm against the *b*schemes of the devil. 12 For our *a*struggle is not against *1b*flesh and blood, but *c*against the rulers, against the powers, against the *d*world forces of this *e*darkness, against the *f*spiritual forces of wickedness in *g*the heavenly places. 13 Therefore, take up *a*the full armor of God, that you may be able to *b*resist in *c*the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. 14 Stand firm therefore, *a*Having Girded Your Loins With Truth, and Having *b*Put On The Breastplate Of Righteousness, 15 and having *a*shod Your Feet With The Preparation Of The Gospel Of Peace; 16 *1*in addition to all, taking up the *a*shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the *b*flaming missiles of *c*the evil one. 17 And take *a*The Helmet Of Salvation, and the *b*sword of the Spirit, which is *c*the word of God. 18 With all *a*prayer and petition *1b*pray at all times *c*in the Spirit, and with this in view, *2d*be on the alert with all *e*perseverance and *f*petition for all the saints, 19 and *a*pray on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me *b*in the opening of my mouth, to make known with *c*boldness *d*the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an *a*ambassador *b*in *1*chains; that *2*in *proclaiming* it I may speak *c*boldly, *d*as I ought to speak.

Eph. 6:21 *a*But that you also may know about my circumstances, how I am doing, *b*Tychicus, *c*the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, will make everything known to you. 22 *1*And *a*I have sent him to you for this very purpose, so that you may know *2*about us, and that he may *b*comfort your hearts.

Eph. 6:23 *a*Peace be to the brethren, and *b*love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. 24 Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ *1*with *a* love incorruptible.
